Middle School Supply List  
2010-2011**

College-ruled loose-leaf paper to replenish as needed

- 8 black or blue ballpoint pens
  - 1 set colored pencils
  - 2 Sharpie ultra fine point pens
  - 2 glue sticks
  - 1 pair Dura Sharp or Fiskars scissors
  - 1 package lined 3 x 5 cards
  - 2 large boxes tissues - homeroom
  - 2 containers Lysol or Clorox wipes - homeroom
  - 1 8 1/2 x 11 or 12 x 12 scrapbook for class trips (to be used all 3 years of middle school, please keep at home)\*
- General scrapbooking supplies to be used after the class trip (can be collected through out the year)\*

\*There will be an digital option for scrapbooking this year, so there is no need to purchase a scrapbook or supplies if you plan to do it digitally.

**Binders:**

In an effort to help the students have fewer binders, the following list tells how much binder space is recommended for each class. Your student can decide whether or not to combine some subjects; however, separate binders are required for Bible and the science lab journal. Please do not buy the large, bulky, fabric binders; they do not fit in the lockers. View-front durable binders are recommended. Look for an email in June with the middle school schedule to better plan which subjects to combine.

- Math – 1 inch
- Language Arts – ¼ inch
- Social Studies – ½ inch
- Science – ½ inch (for science notes)
- Spanish – 1 inch
- Health – ½ inch
- Computer – ¼ inch

**Language Arts:**

- 2 packs multicolor highlighters (yellow, orange, green, pink, blue)

**Math:**

- 2 red pens (1 each semester – to be kept in binder)
- Graph paper (will use for science, too; to be replenished as needed)
- 1 set 4-subject dividers with tabs
- 8 mechanical pencils (or as needed, bring 2 sharpened pencils to class daily)
- 1 old white sock to use for white board eraser (labeled with name)
- 2 fine tip dry erase markers – to be used in class working practice problems
- 1 jumbo size book cover
- 1 ruler (can be small to be used as a straight edge and kept in notebook)
- 1 calculator T1-30X 11S or 11B (or a scientific calculator you already own, solar vs. battery power)

**Science:**

- 1 pair safety goggles (name on goggles with sharpie and placed in Ziploc bag with name on outside)
- 1 jumbo sized book cover
- 1 view-front 1 ½ inch durable 3 ring binder (this binder is to be used as a lab journal and remains in the classroom; please put the student's name on the front cover and on the binding)
- 5 dividers (please label the tabs: notes, homework, computer labs, tests/quizzes, projects)
- 1 photograph or hand drawn picture (5 x 7 or smaller) of some encounter you had with nature over the summer (bring in the first day of school)

**Bible:**

- 1 view-front 1 inch durable binder (not to be shared with other classes)
- 1 NIV Study Bible

**Computer:**

- 1 flash drive with student's name on it (to be used in other classes as well and all 3 years of middle school)
- 1 3 ring pencil pouch (to hold the flash drive in the binder)

**Spanish:**

- 1 Spanish/English dictionary—labeled with student's name
  - 1 set of 5 dividers
  - 1 spiral-bound notebook
  - 1 set spiral-bound index cards
  - 1 plastic folder without brads
- (Please note: Seventh and eighth grade students do not need to buy new supplies for Spanish if their existing supplies are in good condition.)
