**The following list is a consolidated list of supplies needed for middle school. Hopefully this will help when purchasing supplies. On the following page is the list broken down by class/subject for organizing supplies.**

College or wide-ruled loose-leaf paper\*

View-front 1 ½ inch durable 3-ring binder

2 Composition books

3 dividers

2 Sharpie ultra fine point black pens

1 pack multicolor highlighters (yellow, orange, green, pink, blue)

Black wide tip dry erase marker (low odor)

Ruler for straight edge and measuring (inch and metric markings)

2 Jumbo sized book covers (making a book cover out of a brown paper grocery bag works very well)

Glue stick\*

Dura Sharp or Fiskars scissor

Lined 3 x 5 cards (1 package)

3-ring pencil pouch

Old sock

NIV Bible

Pair of safety goggles

Flash drive

Scientific Calculator TI-30XIIS or similar

A photograph or hand drawn picture (5x7 or smaller) of some encounter you had with nature over the summer (bring in the first day of school for Science class)

2 Large boxes of tissues

2 Containers Lysol or Clorox wipes

6<sup>th</sup> Grade – quart size box of Ziploc bags

7<sup>th</sup> Grade – gallon size box of Ziploc bags

8<sup>th</sup> Grade – 2 ½ gallon size box of Ziploc bags (Target sells this size)

\*to be replenished as needed

**Binders**

The two binders in the above list are required for Science Lab and Bible class. They may not be shared with any other class. Beyond those binders, you will need to supply your student with the number of binders that fit their organizational skills. Some students have a small binder for every class, some have a single binder for all classes, and some have a binder for morning and a binder for afternoon classes. The total inches needed in binder width is approximately 3 ½ inches. (Math = 1 inch, Social Studies = 1 inch, Science = 1 inch (for note taking), Language Arts = ¼ inch, Computer = ¼ inch) In order to help you organize supplies, we will e-mail you the 2011-2012 class schedule closer to the beginning of school as it is finalized.

*The Class Trip Scrapbook Projects are under consideration over the summer. 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade should hold onto their scrapbooks/supplies. There is no purchase necessary at this point.*

The list below is for organizing supplies:

**Language Arts:**

2 packs multicolor highlighters (yellow, orange, green, pink, blue)

**Math:**

Wide-ruled notebook paper (for math homework assignments)

Pencils (please, no pen in math)

Ruler for straight edge and measuring (inch and metric markings)

Scientific calculator TI-30XIIS or similar

Graph paper (for occasional graphing, will be used in science as well)

Composition book (to be used as a math journal for taking notes)

3 dividers

Black wide tip dry erase marker

Old sock (for erasing above marker)

Book cover (brown paper grocery bag works great)

**Science:**

1 pair safety goggles (Put student name on goggles with sharpie and placed in Ziploc bag with name on outside of bag.) Sunglass style goggles or goggles with a strap are acceptable. Goggles can be purchased at a hardware store.

1 jumbo sized book cover to cover the science textbook

1 view-front 1 ½ inch durable 3 ring binder (this binder is to be used as a lab journal and remains in the classroom; please put the student's name on the front cover and on the binding) You will need a 1 ½ inch binder as a 1 inch will be too small. This notebook cannot be combined with notes for other classes.

1 inch of space inside a three ring binder for class notes and handouts. Students can choose to have a separate notebook for this or combine their science notes with another class.

1 photograph or hand drawn picture (5 x 7 or smaller) of some encounter you had with nature over the summer (bring in the first day of school)

1 set of colored pencils (can be used for other classes as well)

1 Flash drive. (can be used for other classes as well)

1 package of graph paper (can be used for other classes as well-math)

1 box of Ziploc bags (6<sup>th</sup> grade – quart size, 7<sup>th</sup> grade – gallon size, 8<sup>th</sup> grade – 2 ½ gallon size – Target sells this size)

1 Composition notebook (to stay in science classroom.)

**Bible:**

1 view-front 1 inch durable binder (not to be shared with other classes)

1 NIV Bible

**Computer:**

1 flash drive with student's name on it (to be used in other classes as well and all 3 years of middle school)

1 3 ring pencil pouch (to hold the flash drive in the binder)
