

Out-Of-Uniform Day Dress Code

Out-of-uniform days are noted on the school calendar and are limited due to “Jean Fridays.” On such days, students are expected to dress according to the modesty code below. Parents will be called to bring the appropriate dress to school if the out-of-uniform dress code is not followed.

Girls/Boys

1. All clothing must be neat, well fitting and well maintained.
2. Clothing that is too tight, too loose or too revealing is unacceptable.
3. Dress pants, jeans, jean shorts and capris (for girls) are acceptable. Jeans must be plain and neat (no tears, frays, decorations, embroidery, etc.) Athletic shorts are acceptable as long as they are long. (See #4)
4. Girls may wear skirts, shorts/skorts. **They must be no shorter than 5 inches from the floor when kneeling.**
5. T-shirts are acceptable, but any clothing with suggestive, distasteful or distracting slogans is unacceptable. Sleeveless shirts are not allowed.
6. Hats may not be worn inside the building.
7. Open toed shoes (including flip flops) are acceptable if not a PE day.

JEANS/SPIRIT SHIRT FRIDAY

Students who have followed the school’s dress code during the week and have not received a dress code violation may wear blue jeans and an ECCS school t-shirt (purchased from the school office) on Fridays. Jeans must be plain and neat (no tears, frays, decorations, embroidery, etc.) Girls may also wear jean capris. Solid white, navy, or black under armour type long sleeve shirts may be worn under Friday shirts (for warmth).
