

OUT-OF-UNIFORM DAY DRESS CODE

Out-of-uniform days may occasionally be announced. On such days, students are expected to dress according to the modesty code below. Failure to abide by this policy may result in the loss of this privilege.

Girls/Boys

1. All clothing must be neat, well fitting and well maintained.
2. Clothing that is too tight, too loose or too revealing is unacceptable.
3. Dress pants, jeans, and jean shorts are acceptable.
4. Girls may wear skirts, shorts/skort. **They must be no shorter than five inches from the floor when kneeling.**
5. Wind suits, sweatpants, basketball attire, camouflage pants, etc. are **not acceptable** (if out-of-uniform day falls on PE day, ECCS sweatpants are acceptable).
6. Heavy crew neck shirts, polo shirts, button-front shirts, sweaters and turtlenecks are acceptable. Tasteful, heavy cotton (no thin, undershirt quality) T-shirts are also acceptable. Any clothing with suggestive, distasteful or distracting slogans (including ball team logos) is unacceptable.
7. Hats may not be worn inside the building.
8. Open toed shoes (including flip flops) are acceptable if not PE day.

JEANS/SPIRIT SHIRT FRIDAY

Students may wear blue jeans and the ECCS t-shirt (purchased from school office) every Friday if they choose and have not violated the dress code during the week. Jeans must be **plain and neat** (no tears, frays, decorations, embroidery, etc). Boys and girls may wear jean shorts. (Shorts must be no shorter than five inches from the floor when kneeling.) Girls may also wear jean capris. Solid white, navy, or black under armour type long sleeve shirts may be worn under Friday t-shirts (for warmth).
