

## **Music Teacher**

ECCS is seeking candidates for the position of Music Teacher (long term substitute) beginning in January 2020 through early to mid-March 2020. Candidates for this position must be in agreement with the school philosophy and methodology of teaching and preferably hold skills in music performance, leading worship, and knowledge of music theory and history in order to enrich and enhance the academic curriculum. This is a temporary, part-time, non-benefited position working with K-8th grade students. To these ends, we seek a teacher with qualifications in the following areas:

- Implementation of instruction plans for each class.
- Preparation of materials for class activities.
- Assessment, observation and evaluation of students according to the lesson goals. Keep appropriate student records.
- Maintains a classroom atmosphere consistent with the school philosophy. Keeps students, parents, teachers and administration adequately informed of student progress or deficiencies and gives sufficient notice of issues requiring intervention.
- Prepares students to lead worship and perform the skills they've learned according to prepared expectations. Such events may include chapels or other school programs.
- Prefer (but don't require) Music or Music Education degree or background long with teaching certificate. Willingness to participate in staff meetings and any other required administrative duties.
- Prefer (but don't require) prior classroom teaching experience.

The ideal candidate for this position is someone who is passionate about approaching music and creativity as a part of each of us as an image-bearer of the Creator. The salary for this position is commensurate with the candidate's education, certification and experience.
