Students should read two books, one fiction and one biography, and a Shakespeare play. For each of the three reading assignments, students should complete the corresponding form. All three forms are to be turned in during **Language Arts class on the first day of school**.

Select a **fiction** book from the list below:

1) 6th Grade Fiction List

The God King by Joanne Williamson

Detectives in Togas by Henry Winterfeld

The Eagle of the Ninth by Rosemary Sutcliff

Mara, Daughter of the Nile by Eloise McGraw

Select a **biography** based on the following criteria:

- 2) 6th grade biographies should be at least 100 pages and should be about a worthy person who lived **prior to 400 A.D.** (Examples: Herodotus, Alexander the Great, Cleopatra, Aristotle, Julius Caesar, the Apostle Paul, etc.)

Read a story version of ***A Midsummer Night's Dream*** by William Shakespeare.
