

## Middle School Summer Reading List/6th Grade

Students should read three books—one historical fiction, one biography, and one book of your choice. For each of the three reading assignments, students should complete the corresponding form. All three forms are to be turned in during language arts class on the **first day of school—Wednesday, August 2nd**.

You will read the following **historical fiction** book:

- 1) *Detectives in Togas* by Henry Winterfeld

Select a **biography** based on the following criteria:

- 2) The 6th grade biographies should be at least 100 pages and should be about a worthy person who lived **prior to 400 A.D.** (Examples: Herodotus, Alexander the Great, Cleopatra, Aristotle, Julius Caesar, the Apostle Paul, etc.)

Read a book of **your choice**:

- 3) This book should have appropriate middle school content (does not dishonor God in any way) and length (over 100 pages). Be prepared to share information about your chosen book with the class.
