Students should read the three books listed below. For each of the three reading assignments, students should complete the corresponding form. All three forms are to be turned in during language arts class on the **first day of school—Wednesday, August 2nd**.

You will read **both** of the following **fiction** books:

- 1) *Johnny Tremain* by Esther Forbes. A copy was sent home in your end-of-school packet as a summer loan to be returned on the first day of school.
- 2) *The Last Battle* by C.S. Lewis. If you prefer, you may listen to this using the radio theater version listed below and accessible via this form on the school website.

Select a **biography** based on the following criteria:

(Examples: George Washington, William Wilberforce, Frederick Douglas, Elizabeth II, Martin Luther King, etc.) Please do not choose media stars or sports figures.

- 3) This book should have appropriate middle school content (does not dishonor God in any way) and length (over 100 pages). Turn in this form on the first day of school and be prepared to share information about your chosen book with the class.
