



ECCS is seeking candidates for the position of Elementary Classroom Aide for the 2026-2027 school year. The role of a classroom aide at ECCS requires a unique combination of skills and philosophy. The classroom aide must be in agreement with the school philosophy, theology and methodology of teaching, yet bring understanding and experience to students with a variety of learning needs so that the curriculum can be accessed by all students. This part-time position requires working with students under the direction of the classroom teacher. To these ends, we seek an Elementary Classroom Aide with qualifications in the following areas:

- Assists teacher in the execution of lesson plans.
- Teaches and leads small groups of students or individuals as directed by the classroom teacher.
- Prepares and assembles materials for centers, projects, games, journals, bulletin boards, door decorations, and hall displays.
- Assists in getting take-home materials in and out of student folders.
- Assists in evaluating students' spiritual, emotional, physical, and academic progress.
- Assists in the supervision of students in the classroom, hallways, playground, and on field trips training students to follow classroom rules and love their neighbor.
- Recommends ideas, identifies problems, and aids in problem-solving.
- Fills in for the teacher in her absence and follows lessons plans, and classroom routines.
- Prays for and with the teacher, students, and school families.
- Attends parent and school campus meetings as well as teacher staff meetings.
- Demonstrates a willingness and ability to work under and support the authority of the classroom teacher as well as collaborating with the classroom teacher as needed to meet curriculum and learning objectives.
- Experience working with students having variety of learning needs *is preferred*.

The ideal candidate for this position will have a bachelor's degree, strong organizational skills and demonstrate a passion about approaching working with students as lifelong learners made in God's image. In addition, candidates should be able to articulate a clear Christian testimony, be active in a local church community and demonstrate an ability to come alongside parents in covenant partnership. The compensation for this position is hourly and commensurate with the candidate's education, certification and experience.
