Uniform Code

GIRLS

Regular Uniform (Monday through Thursday)

Tops

- Polo shirt with school logo in red, evergreen, navy, light blue, yellow or white from specified vendor or school-approved embroiderer
 - Middle School: May wear black polos with school logo
 - Woven knit, mesh knit, or quick dry
 - Feminine fit or standard fit
 - Short or long sleeves
- Oxford shirt from uniform line any vendor
 - White or light blue
 - Short or long sleeves
- White “Peter Pan” blouse from uniform line any vendor
 - Short or long sleeves
- Solid white, navy or black long-sleeve shirts or turtlenecks may be worn under polos or Friday shirts
- All shirts must be tucked in all day, regardless of style

Bottoms

- Khaki or navy pants, capris, shorts, skorts, or skirts from uniform line any vendor
 - Belt loops and belts required for all pants and shorts
 - If skirt or skort has belt loops, a belt must be worn
 - May not be tight-fitting
 - Must be fingertip length **OR** 5 inches above the middle of the kneecap **whichever is longer**
- School plaid skirt from specified vendor
- Leggings or bike shorts in solid navy, black, khaki, or white **must be** worn under all skirts and dresses for modesty. Leggings may not be worn as pants.
- Cargo pants and shorts are not allowed

Dresses

- Jumper dresses in khaki or navy from uniform line any vendor with “Peter Pan” blouse, Oxford shirt or school polo shirt as specified above
- Polo dress in navy, light blue, evergreen, or red (logo is optional)
- Must be fingertip length **OR** 5 inches above the middle of the kneecap **whichever is longer**
- Leggings or bike shorts in solid navy, black, khaki, or white **must be** worn under all skirts and dresses for modesty. Leggings may not be worn as pants.

Socks and Shoes

- Closed-toe and closed-heel shoes, ankle boots or athletic shoes
- No Crocs (or other similar slip-on shoes) or rain boots
- Athletic shoes must be worn on PE days
- Wheeled or light-up shoes are not allowed
- No glittery, metallic or shiny shoes (except patent dress shoes)
- Socks that coordinate (solid or pattern, must include uniform colors, or white, black or khaki)

Accessories

- Belts required for all pants and shorts, and any items with belt loops
 - Plain belt in black, brown, khaki or coordinating with uniform (i.e. red, navy)
 - K-5th: Magnetic belt buckles are allowed
- Hair accessories that coordinate
- No dangling or hoop earrings for PE or field trips

Casual Friday**Tops**

- Same as Monday through Thursday **OR**
- ECCS t-shirt

Bottoms

- Same as Monday through Thursday **OR**
- Denim jeans, shorts, skort, or skirt from any vendor
 - No holes or tears
 - No excessive fraying, embroidery or decorations. Minimal fringe on the hem of jeans, skorts, or shorts is permitted, but the fringe does not constitute part of the length of the shorts, skirt, or skort.

All other requirements for length, shoes, accessories and modesty as stated above apply to casual Friday.

Dressy Uniform (Chapel Days and Dressy Field Trips)**Tops**

- K-3rd: White “Peter Pan” blouse
- Grades 4-5/Middle School: White button-down blouse
- Plain shirt with no brand logos
- Short or long sleeves
- All shirts must be tucked in all day, regardless of style

Bottoms

- K-3rd: Navy plaid jumper from specified vendor
- Grades 4-5/Middle School: Navy plaid skirt (pleated or flat front) from specified vendor
- **Jumper or skirt length must be no shorter than the top of the kneecap**

Socks and Shoes

- Navy or white tights or leggings, or white knee socks, are required. K-5th may also wear white fold-over dress socks
- If not wearing leggings or tights, bike shorts must be worn under jumpers or skirts for modesty
- Closed-toe and closed-heel black, beige, brown, or navy non-athletic shoes, ankle boots, and ballet flats are allowed. (Socks are optional with ballet flats; ankle socks are acceptable with ankle boots.)
- Chapel shoes must be worn after chapel until PE or recess, at which time a change of shoes is permitted. Students will NOT be required to change back into chapel shoes after PE/recess.

Optional

- Navy sweater or cardigan (see "Classroom Wear" below)
- Navy blazer, feminine cut

Casual Field Trip

- Navy polo shirt with logo
 - Short or long sleeves
- Field trip coordinator will specify if khakis or jeans may be worn
 - Typically pants, shorts, skirts or skorts are acceptable in specified fabric (khaki or denim)

All other requirements for length, shoes, accessories and modesty as stated above apply to field trips.

BOYS**Regular Uniform (Monday through Thursday)*****Tops***

- Polo shirt with school logo in red, evergreen, navy, light blue, yellow or white from specified vendor or school-approved embroiderer
 - Middle School: May wear black polos with school logo
 - Woven knit, mesh knit, or quick dry
 - Short or long sleeves
- Oxford shirt from uniform line any vendor
 - White or light blue
 - Short or long sleeves
- Solid white, navy or black long-sleeve shirts or turtlenecks may be worn under polos or Friday shirts
- All shirts must be tucked in all day, regardless of style

Bottoms

- Khaki or navy pants or shorts from uniform line any vendor
 - Belt loops and belt required
 - May not be tight fitting
 - Must be fingertip length **OR** 5 inches above the middle of the kneecap
whichever is longer
- Cargo pants and shorts are not allowed

Socks and Shoes

- Closed-toe and closed-heel shoes, or athletic shoes
- No Crocs (or other similar slip-on shoes) or rain boots
- Athletic shoes must be worn on PE days
- Wheeled or light-up shoes are not allowed
- No glittery, metallic or shiny shoes (except patent dress shoes)
- Socks that coordinate (solid or pattern, must include uniform colors, or white, black or khaki)

Accessories

- Belts required for all pants and shorts
 - Plain belt in black, brown, khaki or coordinating with uniform (i.e. red, navy)
 - K-5th: Magnetic belt buckles are allowed

Casual Friday**Tops**

- Same as Monday through Thursday **OR**
- ECCS t-shirt

Bottoms

- Same as Monday through Thursday **OR**
- Denim jeans or shorts from any vendor
 - No holes or tears
 - No excessive fraying, embroidery or decorations. Minimal fringe on the hem of jeans or shorts is permitted, but the fringe does not constitute part of the length of the shorts.
- Belt loops and belt required

All other requirements for length, shoes, accessories and modesty as stated above apply to casual Friday.

Dressy Uniform (Chapel Days and Dressy Field Trips)**Tops**

- Light blue Oxford shirt from any vendor
 - Short or long sleeves
 - Plain with no brand logos
- All shirts must be tucked in all day

Bottoms

- Khaki pants
 - Flat front or pleated
 - Cargo pants are not allowed

- Must have belt loops and belt
- Coordinating black, brown or navy belt

Socks and Shoes

- Closed-toe and closed-heel non-athletic shoes in black, brown, beige or navy
- Socks in blue, black or khaki
- Chapel shoes must be worn after chapel until PE or recess, at which time a change of shoes is permitted. Students will NOT be required to change back into chapel shoes after PE/recess.

Optional

- Navy sweater or sweater vest (see “Classroom Wear” below)
- Tie in red, navy, green, yellow or school plaid
- Navy blazer

Casual Field Trip

- Navy polo shirt with logo
 - Short or long sleeves
- Field trip coordinator will specify if khakis or jeans may be worn
 - Typically pants or shorts are acceptable in specified fabric (khaki or denim)

All other requirements for length, shoes, accessories and modesty as stated above apply to casual field trips.

ALL STUDENTS

OUTERWEAR

Classroom Wear

- Sweaters (*ECCS logo optional*)
 - Navy
 - No hood
 - Vests, pullovers, or cardigans are acceptable

Indoor or Outdoor Wear

- Lightweight jacket (*ECCS logo required*)
 - Navy
 - No hood
 - Pullover, fleece and windbreakers are acceptable
 - Full- or quarter-zip
- Sweatshirt (*ECCS logo required*)
 - Navy
 - No hood
 - Quarter-zip acceptable
 - No other logos or wording
- All sweatshirts and jackets must be worn right-side out

Outdoor Wear

- Winter coats (*ECCS logo optional*)
 - Black, brown, navy, red or grey

- Plain with no décor or large logos
- May have hood
- Cold-weather accessories should coordinate with uniform (navy, black, red, green, yellow, etc.)

Students' names must appear inside all garments, especially sweaters, cardigans, sweatshirts, fleece jackets and outerwear. Please be sure to change the name if an item previously belonged to someone else.

Appearance

- Girls: Hair is to be neatly groomed
- Boys: Hair is to be neatly groomed, off the collar, out of the eyes, and above the ears
- No unnatural hair color permitted
- Clothing must be neat in appearance with no stains, wrinkles or holes
- All shirts must be tucked in all day, regardless of style

Modesty

- Girls' uniform dresses, skirts, skorts and all students' shorts lengths must be fingertip **OR** 5 inches above the middle of the kneecap, **whichever is longer**
- Girls' dressy uniform jumper or skirt lengths must be no shorter than the top of the kneecap
- Girls must wear bike shorts, leggings or tights under dresses, jumpers and skirts
- Leggings may not be worn as pants
- For all students, if length is questionable, parents will be notified by the teacher to either provide a change of clothes that day or in the future
- Clothing may not be tight-fitting

Out of Uniform Days

Out-of-uniform days are noted on the school calendar. On such days, students are expected to dress according to the modesty code.

- All clothing must be neat, well-fitting and well maintained.
- All clothing must be modest, not too tight or too revealing.
- Jeans must be in accordance with the policy specified in the Casual Friday section of the code, as applicable by gender.
- If belt loops are present, a belt must be worn.
- Girls' skirts, shorts and skorts must meet the required length (see modesty guidelines above).
- Athletic shorts are acceptable as long as they meet the required length (see modesty guidelines above).
- No bike shorts, leggings, or other tight-fitting bottoms may be worn without shorts, dresses, or a skirt on top of them.
- Boys' shorts must meet the required length (see modesty guidelines above).
- T-shirts are acceptable, but any clothing with suggestive, distasteful or distracting words, slogans, or images are unacceptable. No sleeveless t-shirts are allowed.
- Modest, sleeveless shirts/dresses are allowed for girls. No tank tops are allowed.
- Hats may **not** be worn inside the building.
- Open-toed shoes are acceptable for out-of-uniform days, as long as it is not a PE day.
- No Crocs or similar slip-on shoes allowed at any time.

Violations

- K-3rd students who have a dress code violation:
 - Lose the privilege of wearing jeans and t-shirts that Friday and must wear their regular uniform.
 - Repeated violations by the same student may result in loss of that dress code element or other action as deemed applicable/necessary by the teacher.
- 4th-5th students who have a dress code violation:
 - Must wear dressy uniform on Friday of that week.
 - If the same student is out of dress code a second time that week or continues to have a problem adhering to the dress code, more serious penalties may be used, including wearing dressy uniform every school day for several days and/or remaining in the office until a parent provides the correct dress.
 - Generally, one day counts as one violation unless deliberate and continual patterns of violation behavior are shown.
- 6th-8th students who have a dress code violation:
 - Must wear dressy uniform on Friday of that week.
 - May be sent to the office until a parent provides the correct dress.

- Three violations of the same dress code element will result in the loss of that dress code element. For example, three violations of skirt length results in no longer being allowed to wear skirts.
- Generally, one day counts as one violation unless deliberate and continual patterns of violation behavior are shown.
- **MODESTY VIOLATIONS** - If the violation is related to modesty:
 - Elementary: Parents will be contacted by the teacher to address the violation and discuss if it is necessary to bring an immediate change of clothes. Repeated violations may result in the loss of that dress code element.
 - Middle School: Students will be sent to the office to be checked; parents will then be contacted to bring a change of clothes. Repeated violations will result in the loss of that dress code element. If possible, the student may be loaned an appropriate item, depending on availability. * (*It is not the school's intent/obligation to keep an inventory of every size/gender of clothing for this purpose. The school has a limited inventory, of which the priority is to provide items for emergency accidents only. If a student is loaned an article of clothing, they must return the item, clean and in its original condition, or replace it with the same.)
