

Middle School Science Shell Collection Project 2021

Next year's collection project will be a shell collection. You will be required to collect and display 12 shells. A notebook with drawings and diagrams will also be required. Details on this project will be handed out sometime during the first two weeks of school.

The students will not be graded on how large or fancy their shells are. I would prefer to have them display shells they have found themselves on the beach or ones found by other family members, but if you are unable to collect shells they may be purchased.

You can collect your shells this summer if you would like to. This is not required and you can certainly wait to gather your shells once the school year begins. For those of you who want to collect this summer, please be certain to record where you found the shell. This will include the town, state and habitat. An example would be: Destin, Florida Habitat- tidal pool
If you purchase the shell, indicate where you purchased it.

A notebook with additional information will be required. This will be done at home during the year but the students will also have some time during computer class, science class and art class time to work on this project.
