⁽¹⁾ Explore More is an optional exploratory class for K-3 held on Monday, Wednesday, or Thursday from 12:15 to 2:45. (Note: Only Monday is available for 3rd grade.)

⁽²⁾ This fee does not include the cost of the spring middle school class trip. This mandatory trip costs approximately \$400-\$900. Fundraisers are organized to partially offset this expense.

The tuition rates include a **15%** tuition reduction for all additional students in the same family (not the first or oldest child). **This discount does not apply to fees.** All tuition and fees shall be paid in full when due. **Once the signed family commitment is received, it is assumed the student is enrolled for the entire year.** Because the school's expenses are incurred on an annual basis, the school sets the budget and teacher contracts based on the parents' enrollment commitment. If a student is withdrawn during the school year, written notice is required and a withdrawal fee equal to one quarter of the annual tuition and the balance of the non-refundable fees (book and supply and activity) is due and payable. This is in addition to the pro-rated tuition up to the last day enrolled in school. The school's financial calendar is June 1-May 31. If a student is withdrawn during the summer (before the first day of school), the family is responsible for tuition equal to one quarter of the annual tuition. Extenuating circumstances may be appealed in writing to the SMT.

Tuition and Fees may be paid in two ways:

During completion of the Enrollment or Re-Enrollment Packet, you will choose your payment option below:

- **One-time payment for the entire year.** Families choosing this option will receive a 2% yearly tuition discount. Payment is due on June 1.
- **Monthly payments through the FACTS Management payment program.** Families authorize an automatic bank draft from their designated savings or checking account. The draft dates are on the 5th or 20th of each month.

Admissions Policy: Priority is given to members of East Cobb Presbyterian Church. Other factors are considered annually.

Admissions Procedures and Age Requirements

1. Application submitted with Application Fee. All Kindergartners must be 5 years old and 1st Graders must be 6 years old before Sept. 1.
2. References checked.
3. If the application is acceptable, an interview is scheduled with parents and student(s) and School Ministry Team members after completing reading and listening requirements.
4. Records of previous schooling and testing is received and reviewed (if applicable).
5. Family notified by phone call and email of status.
